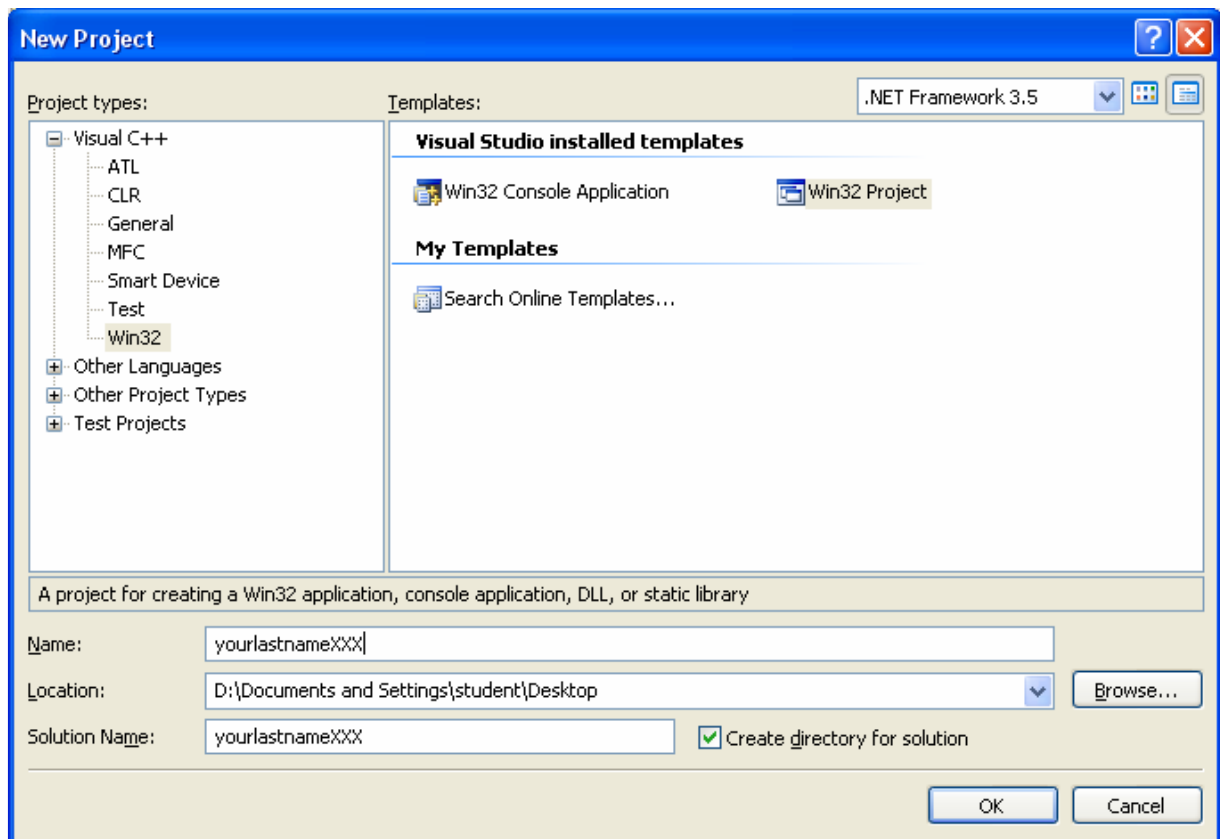
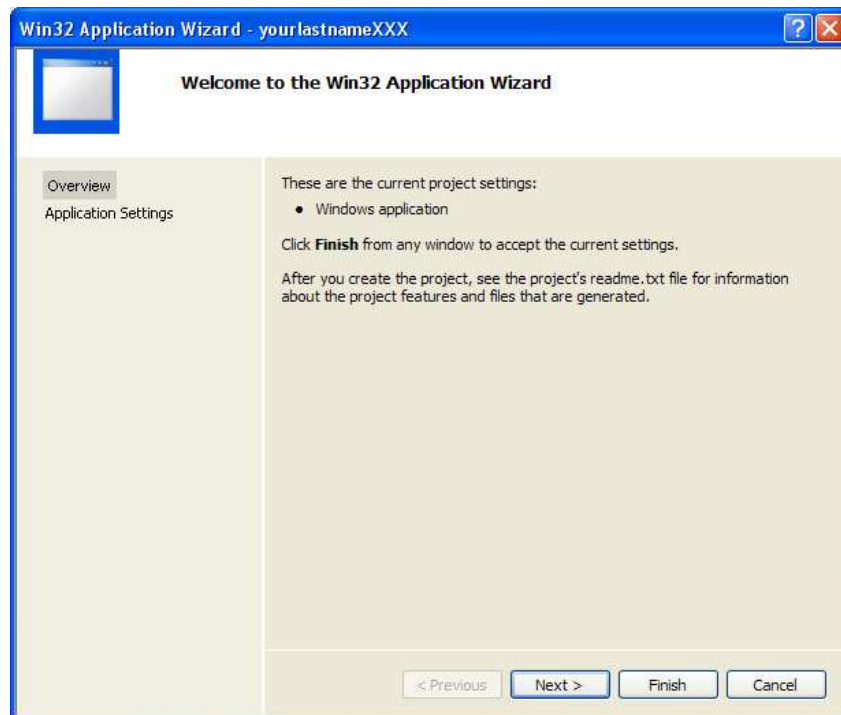


Creating and MFC Project Visual Studio C++ 2008

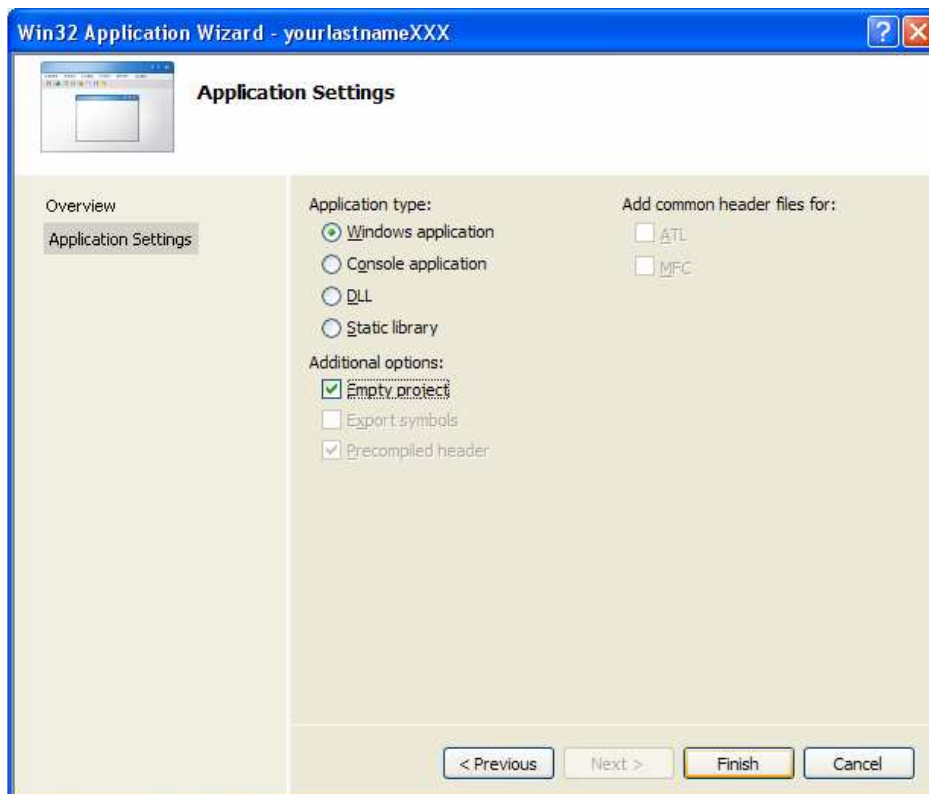
1. Boot your computer into Windows and open up the Visual C++ 2008 IDE.
2. From the *File* menu, select *New*, then *Project*, then *Win32 Project*.
3. Pick a name for your project (*yourlastnameXXX*) and save it to the desktop (or somewhere else where you will be able to find it later):



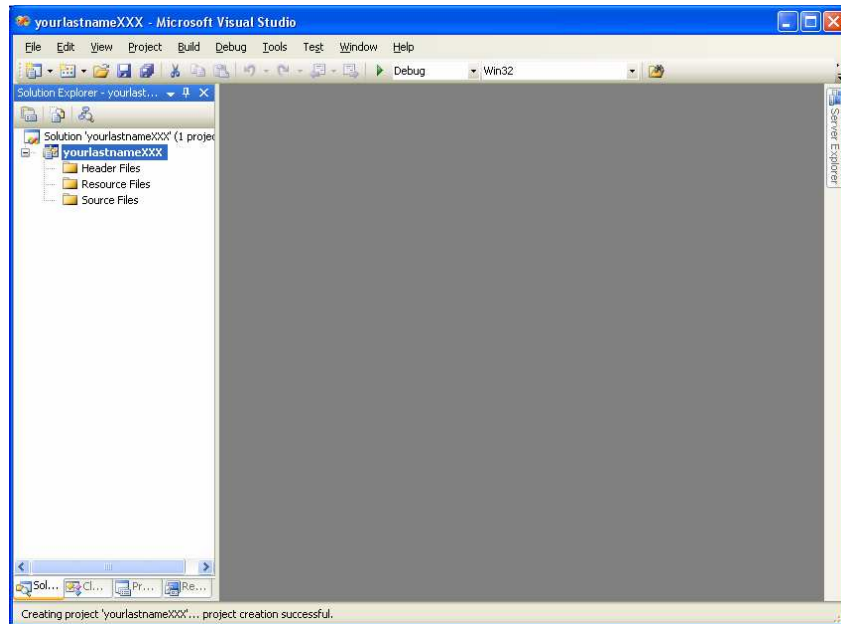
4. In the wizard window that pops up, click Next:



5. On the next Wizard Page select Windows application and Empty project and click Finish:



You will see an empty project window:



6. From the *Project* menu, select *Properties*. In the next window, in the left-hand tab, click "Configuration properties" and then "General". In the right tab, set *Use of MFC* to "Use MFC in a static library" and set *Character Set* to "Not set".
