Question: What should be returned by the constructor with dollars and cents when we have various negative values. Could you tell me what it is supposed to return or have for:

- money(10, 50) -> \$10,50
- money(-10, 50) -> ??
- money(10, -50) -> \$9.50 ? right ?

I believe I need to do something with the flags that istream has, but don't know how to implement it. I was wondering if you could point me in the right direction?
